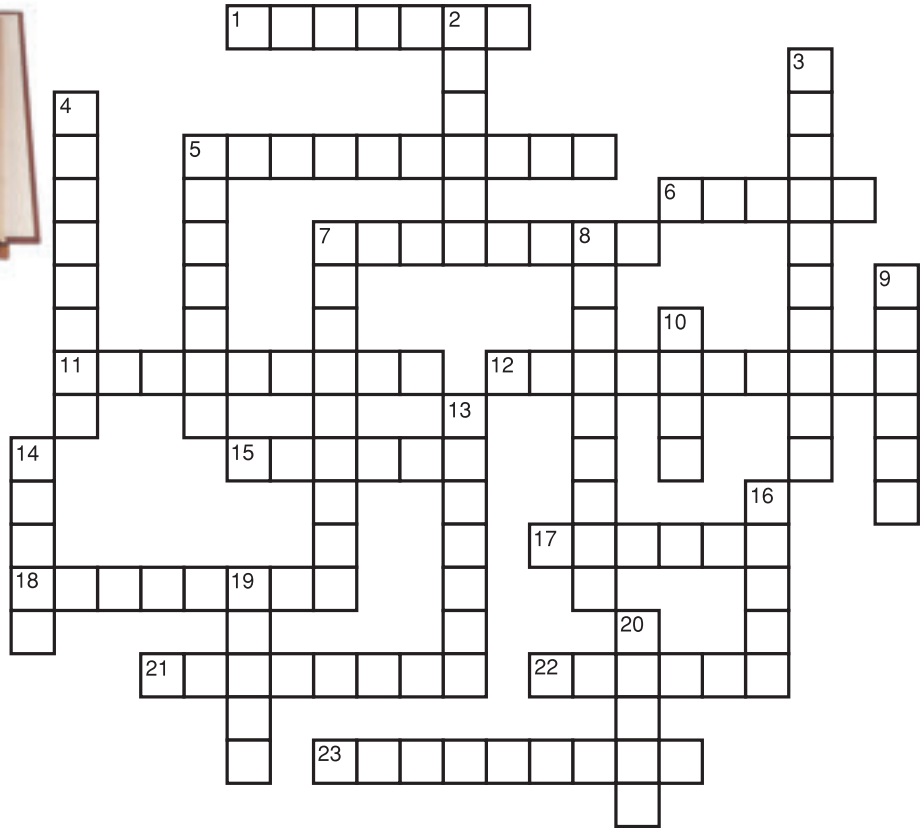

- 1 A close reproduction or facsimile of something, especially by the maker of the original.
- 5 Fired clay, brownish orange in color, used in statuettes, vases, and roofing.
- 6 Derived from the Latin "I see," this term is part of television terminology.
- 7 An engraving in stone or other hard material depressed below the surface of the material so that an impression from the design yields an image in relief.
- 11 A confused heap with, a tangle, or a difficult situation.
- 12 The spread of ideas, information or rumor that either helps or injures a cause or person.
- 15 The modern English meaning came out of Venice and is used to describe a section of a city to which an ethnic or economically depressed minority group is restricted.
- 17 A material made of Portland cement, sand, and lime, used as a covering for exterior walls.
- 18 A hereditary feud between two families.
- 21 A mosaic flooring made by embedding small pieces of marble or granite into mortar.
- 22 The working place of a painter, sculptor, or photographer.
