## Anna Illy

Anna Illy was born in Trieste on November 22<sup>nd</sup>, 1958. Her parents are Ernesto Illy and Anna Rossi Illy. She was married with Guido Belci from 1989 to 2006 and has a daughter, Nicol.

In 1977 she graduated from a scientific high school "Galileo Galileo" in Trieste, and she enriched her education in Public Relations and Marketing.

After an experience in a local shipping agency, working in the transport and logistics sector, in 1978 she enters in the family business.

By taking care of the secretariat of P.E.C. (Physiological Effects of Coffee Committee - Paris) she broadened her knowledge on the science in coffee. She also participated at many editions of the A.S.I.C. (Association for Science and Information on Coffee) meetings on coffee's chemistry.

For a few years she was responsible of illycaffè's purchasing department.

Since 1992 she is part of the Board of Directors of illycaffè s.p.a.

In 1995 Anna IIIy become strategic supply manager, with the specific task of development and co-ordination of the special projects and the initiatives about the strategic supply of raw material.

Since the first edition of the "Premio Brasil de Qualidade do Café para Espresso" (Brazilian Award for best coffee for "Espresso") in 1991, Anna Illy has been a key person of this initiative, developing her knowledge in such an important and delicate sector in addition to her experience in the technical field of green coffee and supply marketing.

In 2000 she participated, in collaboration with University of San Paolo, to the foundation of the "Universidade illy do Café", the first Brazilian academy dedicated to the transfer of knowledge on agribusiness to the coffee producers.

In the same year she participated in the creation of the "Clube illy do Café", where all illycaffè's Brazilian suppliers have the opportunity to participate at special meetings and study trip in Italy.

Since 2002 the initiative of "Premio Brasil de Qualidade do Café para Espresso" has been extended to others producing country, like Guatemala, Colombia and India.

In 2002 illycaffè together with Bicafé Beneficio Industrial de Café and A3K Asociacion Tercer Milenio has instituted in Guatemala the "Projecto Pequenos Productores" (Small Producers Project) with the objective to supply to some groups of small coffee's producers from Jalapa zone, the necessary knowledge for the production of high-quality coffee.
