

Tom Cox is the Chief Executive Officer of OnPoint Group, part of Harvest Partners, a New York-based private equity firm. He previously served as CEO of FCX Performance, another Harvest Partners company.

He spent 17 years as an executive of MSC Industrial Supply, a NY based publicly traded company. Prior to joining MSC, Mr. Cox was President of MailNet, his own Worldwide transportation business.
